General Operations



- Each team will report on arrival to their designated warm-up area.
- Teams and spectators will enter the field when advised to do so.
- Spectator occupancy is restricted to 250 spectators
- All teams and spectators will exit the field immediately after their respective game has ended
 - Allows for cleaning/sanitization prior to next game.
 - Ensures spectator capacity limits are not exceeded.
- No congregating before or after the game
- Spectators must sit in their respective areas (see field map) BRING YOUR CHAIRS
- No tents allowed; No coolers allowed.
- Separate entrance and exit gates will be utilized
- Gate Fees:
 - \$4.00 per adult
 - \$1.00 Student or Senior (Age 62+)
 - Free for Age 12 and under.

Spectator Requirements

- Spectators must conduct daily symptom assessments.
 - Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.*
- Family members must sit together, socially distanced from other individuals/family groups.
 - Six-feet social distancing must be maintained between individuals/family groups
- No congregating before or after practices or games is permitted.
- Spectators must wear face coverings at all times except for any of the allowable exceptions stated in the Director's Order for Facial Coverings (7/23/2020) unless amended
- All spectators must remain stationary with the exceptions of using the restroom or visiting the concession stand
 - Children must remain with their family unless following the exceptions immediately above

Coach / Player Requirements



- Must conduct daily symptom assessments prior to arrival at the field.
 - Anyone experiencing symptoms MUST STAY HOME
- No team congregating before or after the game
- Coaches must wear masks as required
- Coaches/Players must ensure social distancing on the sideline
- No physical, post-game handshakes
